

An ordinance relative to public peace and safety.

THE VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. No person in the Village shall:

- a. Disturb, aid in the disturbing of, or encourage the disturbing of the peace of others by violent, tumultuous or offensive conduct, and no person shall knowingly permit such conduct upon any premises owned or possessed by him or under his control.
- b. Loiter, loaf, wander, stand or remain idle either alone and/or in consort with others in a public place in such manner as to obstruct any public street, highway, sidewalk, or other public place or building by hindering or impeding or tend to hinder or impede the free and uninterrupted passage of vehicles, traffic or pedestrians, or do any act or thing to obstruct or interfere with the free and uninterrupted use of property, lawful assembly or with any business lawfully conducted by anyone.
 1. When any person causes or commits any of the conditions enumerated in subsection a. herein, a police officer or any law enforcement officer shall order that person to stop causing or committing such conditions and to move on or disperse. Any person who fails or refuses to obey such orders shall be guilty of a violation of this section.
- c. disquiet or disturb any congregation or assembly for religious worship by making a noise or by rude or indecent behavior or profane discourse within the place of worship or within a place so near so as to disturb the order solemnity of the worship of the assembly.
- d. Fire, discharge or shot any firearm, toy firearm in which any explosive substance can be used, or bow and arrow within the Village Limits and further that no person shall use or shoot an air gun or air rifle or sling shot in such a manner ~~so~~ as to project or propel a missile out side of such persons premises.
- e. Store, maintain, discard or dispose of any unused refrigerator, or icebox, or any other container or appliance capable of containing a child and having self locking doors on the exterior, without first complying with one or more of the following safety precautions:
 1. The removal of all exterior locks.
 2. The removal of all doors or covers permitting entrance to the appliance.
 3. Padlocking all exterior doors or covers.
 4. Storing the appliance in such a manner as to make entry inaccessible by causing the doors or covers to be firmly pressed against a wall or floor.

SECTION 2. Any person convicted of any of the offenses enumerated in this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$ 100.00 or to imprisonment not to exceed 90 days or both in the discretion of the Court, together with the cost of prosecution.

SECTION 3. Should any Court of competent jurisdiction declare any section or phrase in this ordinance unconstitutional, such decision shall not effect any other section or phrase hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after passage hereof, and shall supersede any existing relative ordinances.
