

## VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD

### CURFEW ORDINANCE

#### Ordinance No. 15.1

An ordinance amending the Village of Clifford Curfew Ordinance to regulate the hours during which minors under the age of 18 years may be in or on the public streets, alleys or parks; and to provide penalties for violations thereof.

#### THE VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Minors Under Fourteen. No minor under the age of fourteen (14) years shall be in or on any public street, alley or park between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. unless the minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or some person at least twenty-one (21) years of age who is designated in writing by the parent or legal guardian to accompany the minor.


Section 2. Minors Under Eighteen. No minor under the age of eighteen (18) years shall be in or upon any public street, alley or park between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m. unless the minor is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or some person twenty-one (21) years of age who is designated in writing by the parent or legal guardian to accompany the minor.


Section 3. Adult Responsibility. No adult shall assist, aid, abet or encourage any minor to violate the provisions of this Ordinance. Parents shall be liable for any property damage or ordinance violations committed by any children for which they have legal custody.

Section 4. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provisions of this Ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction, subject to payments of a civil fine of not less than \$50.00, plus costs and other sanctions, for each infraction. Repeat offenses under this Ordinance shall be subject to increased fines as provided for in the Civil Infraction Ordinance, Ordinance Number 43.

Section 5. Repeal. The former Clifford Village Curfew Ordinance, being Ordinance No. 15, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

The undersigned President and Clerk of the Village of Clifford hereby certify that this Ordinance was duly adopted by the Clifford Village Council on the 17th day of May, 2005, and was published in The County Press on the 25th day of May, 2005.
