

VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD
GARBAGE COLLECTION ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 21A

An ordinance to provide for the pick-up of garbage, trash and refuse in the Village of Clifford and to set the rates therefore.

THE VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Village Council shall from time to time contract with appropriate parties for the picking up of residential garbage, trash and refuse within the Village of Clifford.

Section 2. The Village Council shall from time to time establish by motion any necessary rules and regulations for the depositing of trash, garbage and refuse for the purpose of being picked up.

Section 3. No persons shall store any garbage, trash or refuse upon their premises except in covered containers, kept free from animals, flies and vermin.

Section 4. The Village Council shall from time to time by motion set the size, shape and type of container to be used for the storage of garbage, refuse and trash within the Village so that the containers shall be acceptable to the persons conducting the pick up service.

Section 5. The Village Council shall by motion from time to time set fees for the picking up of garbage, refuse and trash within the Village. Such charges shall be added to the water bill for each user and shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the water bill.

Section 6. The property owner of any property whose property or occupants of such property is serviced by the garbage, trash and refuse pick-up shall be responsible for any charges hereunder.

Section 7. All unpaid garbage collection fees which, on the 1st day of May of each year, have remained unpaid for a period of three months or more, shall be reported to the Village Assessor. The Village Assessor shall transfer such charges, together with any late payment penalties, to the tax roll and assess upon the Village tax roll against the property to which the garbage, trash and refuse pick-up service is made. Said charges shall be collected in the same manner as taxes.

Section 8. Each non-residential use within the Village shall be responsible to arrange for and pay for garbage, trash, and refuse collection.

Section 9. The former Village of Clifford Garbage Collection Ordinance No. 21 adopted on May 19, 1970 and all amendments, resolutions, and motions adopted thereunder are hereby repealed.

Motion by Dailey, supported by LaBlanc to pay current bills. Motion Carried.


Ball tournaments were discussed.
