

VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD
SEMI-TRUCK ORDINANCE

Ordinance Number 48.2

An Ordinance to limit semi-trucks to certain areas and streets within the Village and to prohibit them elsewhere in the Village.

THE VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD ORDAINS:

Section 1. Semi-trucks and trailers shall only be allowed to be operated on Main Street and on the portions of Burlington Street, Clarence Street and Bellamy Street lying between Main Street and the alley located in the block immediately west of Main Street. The operation or parking of semi-trucks and trailers on these streets and alley shall be for delivery purposes only. No parking shall be allowed unless a delivery is in process at the time.

Section 2. Semi-trucks and semi-truck trailers are prohibited from being operated, parked, or located on any street or alley within the Village of Clifford other than those specifically designated in Section 1 above.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provisions of this Ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction, subject to payment of a civil fine of not less than \$50.00, plus costs and other orders and sanctions which may be imposed by the court, for each infraction. Repeat offenses under this Ordinance shall be subject to increased fines as provided for in the Civil Infraction Ordinance, Ordinance Number 43.

Section 4. The former Village of Clifford Semi-Truck Ordinance No. 48 and Semi-Truck Ordinance Amendment No. 48.1 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

The undersigned Clerk of the Village of Clifford hereby certifies that this Ordinance was duly adopted by the Clifford Village Council on the 21st day of August, 2007 and was published in the L A View on the 30th day of August, 2007. This Ordinance becomes effective twenty (20) days after the date of adoption.
