

VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD**PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY CROSS CONNECTION ORDINANCE****ORDINANCE No. 5**

An ordinance to regulate cross-connections with the Public Water Supply System, to adopt by reference the Water Supply Cross Connection Rules of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, to provide for inspections, and to provide for disconnections and civil fines and costs for the violation thereof.

THE VILLAGE OF CLIFFORD ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. That the Village of Clifford adopts by reference the Water Supply Cross Connection Rules of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality being R 325.11401 to R 325.11407 of the Michigan Administrative Code.

SECTION 2. That it shall be the duty of the Village of Clifford to cause inspections to be made of all properties served by the public water supply where cross connections with the public water supply is deemed possible. The frequency of inspections and reinspections based on potential health hazards involved shall be as established by the Village of Clifford and as approved by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality.

SECTION 3. That a representative of the Village Water Supervisor shall have the right to enter any reasonable time any property served by a connection to the public water supply system of the Village for the purpose of inspecting the piping system or systems thereof for cross connections. On request, the owner, lessees, or occupants of any property so served shall furnish to the inspection agency any pertinent information regarding the piping system or systems on such property. The refusal of such information or refusal of access, when requested, shall be deemed evidence of the presence of cross connections.

SECTION 4. That the Village of Clifford is hereby authorized and directed to discontinue water service after reasonable notice to any property wherein any connection in violation of this ordinance exists and to take such other precautionary measures deemed necessary to eliminate any danger of contamination of the public water supply system. Water service to such property shall not be restored until the cross connection has been eliminated in compliance with the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. The potable water supply made available on the properties served by the public water supply shall be protected from possible contamination as specified by this ordinance and by

the Michigan and Village Plumbing Code. Any water outlet which could be used for potable or domestic purposes and which is not supplied by the potable system must be labeled in a conspicuous manner:


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SECTION 6. That this ordinance does not supersede the Michigan Plumbing Code or Ordinance No. 37, but is supplementary to them.


SECTION 7. The Village clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall at the same time publish a notice that a complete copy of the Water Supply Cross Connection Rules of the Michigan Department of Public Health is available at the office of the clerk for inspection.

SECTION 8. Violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a municipal civil infraction. Each day upon which a violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall occur shall be deemed a separate and additional violation.

The undersigned President and Clerk of the Village of Clifford hereby certify that this Ordinance was duly adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Clifford at a meeting held on the 21 day of April, 1998 and was published in the Marlette Leader on the 29 day of April, 1998. This ordinance shall take affect 20 days after said date of adoption.
