

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE HAWKERS, PEDDLERS AND VENDORS, AND TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF GOODS, WARES, MERCHANDISE, FRUITS VEGETABLES FOODSTUFFS OR SERVICES WITHOUT A LICENSE.

Section 1.

No person, firm, or corporation shall engage in the business of hawking, peddling or vending any goods, wares, merchandise, fruits, vegetables, foodstuffs or services from door to door or upon the streets, alleys and public places, or from any hotel or rooming house, either by sample or by taking orders, or otherwise, for delivery then or in the future, without first obtaining a license as hereinafter provided.

Section 2.

Each person desiring to obtain a license for the aforementioned purposes shall make application therefore to the Village Clerk. Such application shall be in writing, shall state the name and permanent address of the applicant, the length of time the applicant expects to continue said business in the village, the article or articles to be offered for sale, and any other information which may be required by the Clerk. If acting as the agent of any person, firm or corporation in the sale of such articles, the applicant shall also state the name and address of such principal.

Section 3.

Upon receipt of the application provided for in the preceding section, and the payment of the appropriate fee according to the schedule hereinafter provided, the Clerk shall issue to the applicant a proper license which shall show on its face the information required in the application, the date of issue, and the expiration, and shall be signed by the village clerk and countersigned by the Village Treasurer. No license shall be granted for a period greater than one year, nor shall any license be transferable or assignable.

Section 4.

Each person to whom such a license is granted under this Ordinance, shall pay the following fees therefore to the Village Treasurer:

For one Year-----	\$25.00
For six months-----	\$15.00
For one month-----	\$10.00
For any period less than one month-----	\$1.00 per day.

Persons engaged in selling or soliciting in interstate commerce, upon presentation of evidence thereof satisfactory to the Village Clerk or Marshall, shall be licensed without the payment of fees herein provided.

All fees under this ordinance shall be paid to the village Treasurer, who shall account for them at each Village Council meeting.

Section 5.

Persons licensed under this ordinance shall carry said license at all times when hawking or selling, and shall display said license upon demand of any adult resident of the Village. Failure to display a license when properly requested shall be deemed a violation of this ordinance.

Section 6.

Any license granted under this ordinance may be revoked by the village president whenever in his judgement it is for the best interests of the community to do so, having in mind the welfare, safety and health of the community. Such revocation shall be only after licensee has had reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard

Section 7.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or to imprisonment not to exceed 90 days, or both, in the discretion of the court, together with the costs of prosecution, for each violation. Each day that said person, firm or corporation shall operate without complying with this ordinance shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 8.

The above said resolution and ordinance to take affect commencing on February 1, 1955.
